The bulk of the discussion is given over to ordinary and necessary expenses and whether or not an artistic activity is engaged in for profit. These three subsections provide a microcosm of the books diversity available in each chapter which will surprise and inform the reader. Cultural property is covered in Chapter 6, International Trade in sections covering import-export and, naturally, cultural property. All great law treatises provide that perspective and this one succeeds. It will not help the practitioner of art law distinguish dreck from fine art. Start looking at pictures, visiting museums and attending lectures. But unlike the other two art law treatises cited earlier, it will introduce the lawyer to the unique framework provided by Ms. Darraby in the analysis of art, artifact and architecture law issues. For myself, as a reviewer and user of this work, I hope that this statement is a coming attraction for a second volume to this wonderful work of scholarship.
