Rumors began circulating immediately concerning his possible assassination. The rumors arose for a good reason. Taylor, a Southerner, opposed the growth of slavery in the United States despite being a slave owner himself. While President, Taylor had worked to prevent the expansion of slavery into the newly acquired California and Utah territories, then under the control of the federal government. Taylor prodded those future states, which he knew would draft state constitutions banning slavery, to finish those constitutions so that they could be admitted to the Union as free states. Davis, who would go on to be the first and only President of the Confederate States of America, had campaigned vigorously throughout the South for Taylor, assuring Southerners that Taylor would be friendly to their interests. A career military man, Taylor hewed to the time honored tradition of taking no public positions on political issues. Taylor believed it was improper for him to take political positions because he had sworn to serve the Commander-in-Chief, without regard to person or party. Indeed, he had never even voted in a Presidential election before running himself. Tensions between Taylor and the South grew when Henry Clay proposed his Great Compromise of , which offered something for every interest. Wikinews has related news: Fatal shooting at school in Pennsylvania, USA Roberts backed a pickup truck up to the front of the Amish schoolhouse and entered it at approximately EDT, shortly after the children had returned from recess. He asked the teacher, Emma Mae Zook, and the students if they had seen a missing clevis pin on the road. Survivors said he mumbled his words and did not make direct eye contact. After they denied seeing a clevis pin, he left to his truck and reentered holding a Springfield XD 9mm handgun. He ordered the boys to help him carry items into the classroom from the truck. Zook and her mother, who was visiting, took this opportunity to escape and run toward a nearby farm for help. Roberts saw them leave, and ordered one of the boys to stop them, threatening to shoot everyone if they got away. Meanwhile, the boys carried in lumber, a shotgun, a stun-gun, wires, chains, nails, tools, a small bag and wooden board with multiple sets of metal eye-hooks. The bag held a change of clothes, toilet paper, candles, and flexible plastic ties. Using wooden boards, Roberts barricaded the front door. One girl, nine-year-old Emma Fisher, escaped without her older sister. An article, Revisiting the Amish Schoolhouse Massacre, described the situation prior to the arrival of the first state police troopers: Hoping for an opportunity to help the little girls, he slowly crept around one side of the wooden structure and positioned himself as an observer next to a side window. That would be the last successful attempt at an unnoticed move upon the building by anyone. The police, while waiting for reinforcements, attempted to communicate with Roberts via the PA system in their patrol cars. Roberts refused, again ordering the officers to leave. County and state police dispatchers had briefly established telephone contact with Roberts as he continued to threaten violence against the children. Some conversed among themselves throughout the ordeal. Shortly before Roberts opened fire, two sisters, Marian and Barbara Fisher, 13 and 11, requested that they be shot first that the others might be spared. Barbara was wounded, while Marian was killed. A team of officers was positioned just behind a shed attached to the rear corner of the schoolhouse and they requested permission over the radio to approach the windows. The permission was denied. State troopers immediately approached. As the first trooper in line reached a window, the shooting abruptly stopped; Roberts had committed suicide. During the shooting, he fired at least 13 rounds from his pistol. The first medical helicopter was dispatched. Troopers and local officers continued to tend to the girls, helping the emergency medical technicians provide first aid on the school playground. Ambulances arrived just as the wounded girls were being carried out of the schoolhouse. Helicopters landed shortly thereafter and those still living were taken away for medical treatment. He had three children and a wife, for whom he left four separate suicide notes. They also claimed that he seemed to return to normal in the week leading up to the shooting. Miller hypothesizes that this "calm" may have been when he Roberts decided to go through with the shooting. Roberts returned home a little before Roberts called his wife from the schoolhouse on his cell phone and told her that he had molested two young female relatives between the ages of 3 and 5 20 years previously when he was 12 and had been daydreaming about molesting again. One note Roberts left behind indicated his despondency over a daughter who died approximately 20 minutes after birth nine years earlier. He stated that he had "been having dreams for the past couple of years about doing what he did 20 years ago and he has dreams of doing them again", according to State Police Commissioner Colonel Jeffrey Miller. In some cases the transcript indicates the line went dead because the call was transferred to state police and was not recorded by Lancaster County. About the time of this initial call for help, a pregnant woman, three parents with infants, and all 15 male students were told to leave the school by Roberts. As the first few troopers approached the building, Roberts ordered them to leave or else he would start shooting. An agitated Roberts continued to demand that police leave as the troopers attempted to communicate with Roberts via the PA system in their police cars. He had arranged the bound girls at the front of the classroom, near the chalkboard. Roberts made two cell phone calls, one to his wife and the next to police. He warned the dispatcher that if state police were not off the property in two seconds, he would kill the children. The

dispatcher attempted to delay him and put him in touch with the State Police, but Roberts ended the call. Two of the girls then began negotiating with Roberts. They pleaded for him to shoot them first. This allowed the girls a little extra time for possible rescue. Roberts called after arriving home from a prayer study group meeting. She had discovered a suicide note left on the kitchen table and had received a brief and disturbing emotional phone call from her husband. The dispatcher put her in touch with State Police. Two had died at the school house, one was pronounced dead on arrival at Lancaster General Hospital, and two sisters survived until the early hours of October 3 when they were taken off life support. The surviving victims of the immediate attack were brought to Lancaster General Hospital, stabilized, and then transferred to hospitals with pediatric trauma care. Three children were admitted to Milton S. Reports stated that most of the girls were shot "execution-style" in the back of the head. Miller said Roberts shot his victims in the head at close range, with 17 or 18 shots fired in all, including the one he used to take his own life as police stormed into the school by breaking through the window glass. Janice Ballenger, deputy coroner in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, counted at least a dozen shotgun pellet inflicted wounds in one child alone before asking a colleague to take over and continue for her. There were bullet holes everywhere, everywhere. Miller presented the State Police Medal of Honor to ten Pennsylvania State Troopers in appreciation for their efforts to assist the victims. Local police officers and emergency personnel were presented commendations by the Bart Township Fire Company. The Amish have also set up a charitable fund for the family of the shooter. She wrote, "Your love for our family has helped to provide the healing we so desperately need. Your compassion has reached beyond our family, beyond our community, and is changing our world, and for this we sincerely thank you. Richie Lauer, director of the Anabaptist Foundation, said the Amish community, whose religious beliefs prohibit them from having health insurance, will likely use the donations to help pay the medical costs of the hospitalized children. They explained that the Amish willingness to forgo vengeance does not undo the tragedy or pardon the wrong, but rather constitutes a first step toward a future that is more hopeful. I would just lock the kitties in another room when babies come to visit. I just wanted to add though that if this was more than scratches and instead actually deep bites get yourself to a doctor. If the bites are deep you may want to go to the doctor now and ask them about preventive antibiotics. When my cats do this, it can take hours for them to recover. Good idea on putting them in your spare room. It gives them a "safe" area to calm down. My mom went to pick me up and the cat decided to defend her against me, the object of her distress. Cats are under the mistaken belief that they live in a democracy with their humans, not a benevolent dictatorship. Like if a cat gets stuck somewhere and is scared and bites their rescuer. This sounds over-the-top aggressive to me, and I am so sorry it happened. I would be totally freaked out too. Attend to your injuries immediately, and consult with a vet who can help you find an expert in aggression. In the kindest light, the cats made a REALLY bad judgment call, based on their limited evidence never having seen a baby before, feeling ownership of the house and its order, and being cats, who are, pretty much, assholes, which is why we like them. Many housecats are, in a way, like collies. They guard and protect the house. And this is pretty par for the course. My old guy RIP! The lesson I took home for me: The cat lives there. The cats were attacking me. They are back to their normal selves now and I keep randomly playing clips of babies crying from YouTube to get them acclimated to the sound because yes, the plan is to add a tiny human to the household by next year. The first time I played a clip one of my cats began hissing and started lunging at me, then pawing my iPhone. Anyhow, I do believe it was the sound of the baby crying that flipped the cats out. These cats usually love attention from all kinds of humans. And even though i cleaned all the wounds and scratches with alcohol, I did wind up going to the doctor who gave me an injection of antibiotics. Thanks for all the suggestions.
