Her futuristic weapons systems include lasers, missiles, and—eventually—an electromagnetic railgun that can fire pound projectiles at speeds of Mach 7 without using gunpowder. The Zumwalt—like the admiral—is controversial. The cost overruns led Congress and the Navy to scrap plans for 32 ships in the class to just three. None of these improvements are bad by themselves, but all together they posed a bridge too far. We should use the lessons we learn from the Zumwalt class to inform our thinking about the future large surface combatants we will need to reinforce and replace our existing ships. Defense research and development has fallen to just 0. In Vietnam, he reduced the casualty rate among sailors serving on Swift boats in the Mekong Delta from 80 percent to 10 percent. He did so by removing the dense foliage along the riverbanks in which enemy snipers hid. At the time, the preferred defoliant was believed to be safe to humans.
