**How to view two-page spreads** What a two-page spread is A two-page spread is a printing convention that represents leading and trailing pages in a bound or folded project such as a book, booklet, newsletter, or greeting card. Often, the pages in a two-page spread mirror one another. For example, pages 2 and 3 of this four-page newsletter make up a two-page spread. If you compare the locations of page numbers, running titles, and margins on pages 2 and 3, you can see that page 3 is a mirror image of page 2. Not all two-page spreads have a mirrored-page layout, however. In this greeting card that opens from bottom to top, the inside of the card is a two-page spread. The page sorter the control at the bottom right of the publication window that consists of page-shaped icons looks like this for both the four-page newsletter and the greeting card. In the newsletter, each page is represented by one page icon in the page sorter. In the greeting card, each surface that contains unique content is considered to be a page. Notice how the icon for pages 2 and 3 looks like facing pages. What a two-page spread is not A two-page spread is not just any two pages in a publication. In publications such as postcards and brochures that have a front and back side, the two sides are not a two-page spread. Each side has content on it, but the sides are not meant to be viewed at the same time. You can view either the front or back side of this postcard. The page sorter for a postcard looks like the following. The front and back sides of the card are each represented by a page icon. Web publications consist of a series of individual pages that cannot be viewed as two-page spreads. To find out if you are in a Web publication, look at the title bar. It displays either Print Publication or Web Publication, depending on the type of publication that you have open. On a Web site, each page stands alone. When you have a Web publication open, therefore, the Two-Page Spread option is not available on the View menu. If you just want to display two or more pages at the same time so that you can see them in relation to one another, you can do that in Print Preview. On the File menu, click Print Preview. Click the Multiple Pages button and then choose the number of pages you want to display. How do I view two-page spreads? On the View menu, select Two-Page Spread. A publication must have at least three pages in order for you to see the results of selecting Two-Page Spread. On the page sorter, click the icon for pages 2 and 3 to see a two-page spread. To switch back to viewing one page at a time, on the View menu, clear the Two-Page Spread check box. Expand your Office skills.

Select More Preset Page Sizes at the bottom of the drop-down menu. Click the Booklets folder. Other folders contain other page sizes. Begin typing the content for the booklet in the first text box after the title or paste it from another document. When there is too much text for the box, an Overflow Indicator appears on the border. Click the Overflow Indicator and then click the next text box so the words can flow from one text box into the next. When the second text box is full, click the Overflow Indicator again to link it to the third, then link the third text box to the fourth until your four-page booklet is filled. Click the Home tab and format the text as desired. To use headings in the booklet, highlight the heading and then select a style from the Style icon in the Home ribbon. Adding Images to the Booklet credit: Add images from your computer by clicking the Insert menu and then clicking Pictures. Drag any corner of the image to resize it without distorting its aspect ratio. To move an image, just drag it to where you want it to appear. Right-click the image and click the Text Wrap icon if you need to adjust the way text wraps around the picture. By default, Text Wrap is enabled, but you can make the image appear beneath the text, over the text, or have it in-line with the text. Printing the Booklet credit: Click the File tab when you are ready to print the booklet. Select Letter-sized paper in the Settings section and then examine each page in the Preview window. Click the Arrow beneath the preview to examine other pages.

1. Start Microsoft Word or Publisher. On Publisher's Available Templates screen, click the "Programs" button. Double-click the "1/2 Letter Booklet x " button in the Blank Sizes section.

In fact, after the initial setup of most documents, navigation and functionality is extremely close, and the choice of program may be more one of preference or availability. For desktop publishing projects like setting up a book, both Word and Publisher offer quickstart templates and assistance along the way to starting your next bestseller. Now as you add text, words flow from one text box to another. If you run out of room in the second box you can link to another text box, and the text will flow through all three boxes. Add Building Blocks to your publication Building blocks are reusable pieces of content such as headings, calendars, borders, and advertisements. Publisher has built-in building blocks, or you can create your own. In the Page Navigation pane, select a page in your publication. Click a building block.
