

Chapter 1 : Golden Gate Bridge - HISTORY

What is the significance of the Eastern Gate of Jerusalem? The Old City of Jerusalem is surrounded by a wall containing eight major gates. The Eastern Gate, facing the Mount of Olives across the Kidron Valley, is unique in that it is completely sealed shut. Also, it is the gate that gives the most direct access to the temple mount—“if a person could pass through the arches of the Eastern Gate, he would be very close to where the Jewish temple used to stand. Jewish tradition states that the Messiah will pass through the Eastern Gate when He comes to rule. The Eastern Gate has remained sealed for nearly the past years. The book of Ezekiel contains several references to a gate that faces east. Then, in Ezekiel It must not be opened; no one may enter through it. It is to remain shut because the Lord, the God of Israel, has entered through it. Then he shall go out, and after he has gone out, the gate will be shut. The glory of the Lord coming into the temple is seen as the triumphal entry Ezekiel The command to permanently shut the gate because the Lord has entered it Ezekiel This interpretation is popular and leads to much dramatic speculation about how and when the Eastern Gate will be unsealed. However, there are some textual problems with that interpretation. Second, the Eastern Gate of Jerusalem is not the same one that Jesus rode through in His triumphal entry. The modern Eastern Gate was not constructed until centuries after the time of Christ. The original gate that Nehemiah built and possibly dating to the time of Solomon is underground, below the current gate, as documented by archaeologist James Fleming in It was through the lower gate now underground that Jesus would have entered Jerusalem in AD Third, the temple that Ezekiel sees in chapters 40—47 is not the same temple that Jesus was in, and the Jerusalem he describes is quite different from the Old City of Jerusalem that we know of today. The millennial temple the third temple measured in Ezekiel is significantly larger than the first two temples, and the Jerusalem of the millennium will have twelve gates, not eight Ezekiel Rather, he is the overseer of Jerusalem during the millennial kingdom. We know that this prince is not the Lord because he must make a sin offering for himself as well as the people: Whoever the prince is, he is a man with a sin nature that must be atoned for. The current sealed gate did not exist at the time of Christ, so the Lord never entered it. The location of the earlier Eastern Gate the one Jesus entered is below present-day ground level, and it does not agree with the detailed description of the future temple complex as given in Ezekiel 40— We surmise, then, that the eastern gate of Ezekiel 44 will be part of the future millennial temple complex. It is yet to be built. Later, in chapter 43, Ezekiel sees the glory return to the temple—“this is the new, enlarged temple of the millennial kingdom. In other words, in the millennium the glory of the Lord will not depart from the temple. The avenue of the prior exit to the east is blocked, symbolizing the permanent presence of the Lord among His people. The eastern gate will only be opened on the Sabbath and the New Moon to allow for the priestly duties of the prince Ezekiel

Walking across the bridge For anyone who likes to be able to pull out their camera and catch that perfect shot when you see it, a stroll across the Golden Gate Bridge means you can do just that. Pedestrians are allowed to use the east sidewalk of the bridge days a year, with the opening hours depending on the time of year. How long does it take to cross the bridge on foot? Give yourself plenty of time so you can forget about having to look at your watch and just enjoy the experience. If you decide you like the option of walking there are some things you need to note. No dogs or other animals are allowed unless they are service animals. Walking does mean walking. No roller blades, skateboards, or other wheeled forms of getting around. The two exceptions are bicycles and wheelchairs. Crossing the bridge is toll-free for cyclists, and is open 24 hours a day. Under normal operation, cyclists are required to use the east or the west side of the bridge depending on the time of day. However, until September , the west side is closed for maintenance, so bicycles must use the east side until this work is finished. The night hours for cyclists over the bridge are from 9 pm to 5 am during Daylight Savings Time, and from 6 pm to 5 am during Pacific Standard Time. If you want to cycle across the Golden Gate Bridge at night, the entry is on the east side. Press this and then wait for the security staff to open the gate remotely. This may take a few moments as they have to verify where you are on security camera before they can open the gate. They can also provide you with some maps and routes around the area if you want to make a day of it. The buses are open top and you can purchase a 24 hour or a 48 hour ticket. For more information see this bus tour page. There are car parks at either end of the bridge if you want to do a combo car and walk. The northeast side car park is free and you are able to park here for up to four hours which makes it a good choice. Weather and safety at the Golden Gate Bridge San Francisco is famous for its fog and it can roll in off the sea at just about any time of year. And with it comes cold and dampness, so wearing layers when you visit the bridge is a good idea. Most are great at sharing the sidewalk, but the odd few do come barreling along with no regard for others. Keep an eye out and be ready to get out of the way just in case. FasTrak services remain the same with two exceptions: Click here for hours of operation. Yes, anyone can use FasTrak. Opening a FasTrak Account requires an initial prepaid toll balance and the use of a toll tag. If you cross other Bay Area toll bridges in addition to your trips across the Golden Gate Bridge, FasTrak may likely be the most convenient choice for you. What is the prepaid toll balance required to open a FasTrak account? After establishing a FasTrak Account, the replenishment amount may increase based on the frequency of your crossings. I want to use cash to open and replenish a FasTrak Account, how can I do that? What does the FasTrak toll tag cost? As you go through the Toll Plaza, when FasTrak toll tag signal is detected correctly, you hear a beep. If the toll tag signal is not detected, digital cameras capture images of your license plates. So as long as your correct license plate number is on file with your FasTrak Account, your account will automatically be charged the correct toll. To avoid getting a Toll Invoice, take action now! You can also pay with cash if you prefer. How often are Toll Invoices generated and mailed? Thereafter, invoices are mailed on a day cycle if the customer crossed the Bridge again in the same vehicle. Yes, but Toll Invoices will be mailed to the registered owner of the vehicle and must be paid within 21 days after being generated. If the first Toll Violation notice goes unpaid, a second Toll Violation notice is issued with increase penalties is goes unpaid, the amount due is referred the DMV who withhold your vehicle registration until the penalties are paid. For out-of-state vehicles, the matter is referred to a collections agency. It is most likely that the license plate number shown on the invoice was not yet added to your FasTrak Account or License Plate Account. To be sure that the correct license plate information is associated with your account, please update your account information: I was sent a Toll Invoice with a license plate number listed that is not my vehicle, what do I do to correct this? This can happen from time to time. What about vehicles with DMV-issued decals? During designated carpool hours, toll lane 2 on the right side of the Toll Plaza is the designated carpool toll lane. This designated carpool toll lane is only for eligible carpool vehicles and vehicles with the white DMV-issued Clean Air Vehicle Decal. Eligible carpool vehicles include two-axle vehicles with three or more persons, motorcycles, and buses. Rental Vehicles Does my rental car company have a tolling program? Most of the major rental car companies offer a convenience fee-based tolling program, which is likely the most convenient toll payment option to use. Please check with your rental agent at the time of your reservation on their tolling program. This is not recommended practice. You can add a rental car to your existing FasTrak Account by adding the license plate number of the rental vehicle to the account and using your own toll tag. We do not recommend this action for a couple of reasons. Further, you run the risk of leaving your FasTrak toll tag in the rented vehicle. In order to avoid being charged tolls that you did not accrue, be sure to take the toll tag out of the rental vehicle at the end of your rental period AND remove the rented vehicle license plate from your FasTrak Account. What if I opt-out of the tolling program offered to me and I take no action to pay my toll? Please inquire with the rental agent at the time of your reservation on their tolling policies and any fees that they may associate with their polices. And in turn, you will be charged the toll amount due on the Toll Invoice plus additional fees, depending on the policy of the car rental company. The decision to convert to all electronic tolling was made in January Of the 28 full-time Toll Collectors who wished to remain employed with the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District, more than half transitioned to other District positions. The Golden Gate Bridge converted to all electronic tolling for several key reasons. What is all electronic tolling and how does it work? Motorists no longer stop at the Toll Plaza. Equipment in the Toll Plaza includes antennas that detect a signal from FasTrak toll tags and digital cameras that capture license plate images. License plate images are used to link and post the toll transaction to a FasTrak Account if the toll tag signal is not captured , or one of three Pay-By-Plate payment options: Did the conversion to all electronic tolling improve traffic for motorists? When electronic tolling with FasTrak was added at the Golden Gate Bridge in July , the traffic congestion during the weekday morning commute was immediately improved,

with typical wait times at the Toll Plaza dropping from up to 20 minutes to under a minute. Today, traffic congestion does occur during the evening weekday commute periods and on weekend evenings. Much of this congestion is due to the higher percentage of customers stopping to pay cash during these time periods. When all electronic tolling is implemented, cash will no longer be accepted and motorists will not stop at the Toll Plaza which should improve the flow of traffic during these times. Can I still pay my toll using cash? There is no need to drive through a specific toll lane or even stop at the Toll Plaza. Where can I read the privacy policy for all electronic tolling? License plate information that is collected as a part of all electronic tolling is used only for the purposes of toll collection. Data collected for the purposes of assessing tolls in California is eliminated from the data systems in accordance with Senate Bill

Total crossings: Through October 30, , the Golden Gate Bridge Highway District reported 1,, vehicles had crossed the bridge Closures: The bridge has been closed three times for weather, for gusting winds more than 70 mph.

It has six lanes for cars. Walkers and bikers use special sidewalks to cross. It is a little overwhelming to drive over it for the first time -- so work hard to concentrate on the road and not the scenery. The lanes are not very wide. The right hand lane is the largest of the three, so use this one when you cross. Once you get over it, there is a great look out point. Try to be in the right lane as you are reaching the end of it. The viewing area is the first exit on the right after the bridge. The parking lot is large and is usually busy so be cautious as you drive into the lot. The Golden Gate Bridge Toll is just for southbound traffic. You no longer need to stop to pay the toll. When you reach the toll plaza, simply continue driving. You will either be automatically charged on your FastTrak or you will receive a bill in the mail. There are no longer any human toll takers at the toll plaza. Walkers use the path on the east side. You can also park your car in a designated parking area either at the north or south end. You can then walk only part of the way. If you decide you want to walk it, I recommend that you start as soon as the walkway opens in the morning. The walkway is pretty large, but it gets really crowded around 11 am and is pretty busy for the remainder of the day. Looking up at the southern tower from the walking path that is free and open to the public If you want to walk just a short distance, then I recommend driving over first and walking from the north side. You can get some amazing shots of the bay, Alcatraz and its large towers. You will want to layer your clothes in case it gets warmer or cooler during your walk. It is amazing how beautiful it can be below and then how cold and windy it will feel on the bridge. Make sure you are prepared for either temperature. Are you interested in taking a tour? Golden Gate Bridge History: Tips for Biking You can also ride your bike over it. During the week, the walkers and bicyclists share the path on the east side. There are several bike rental places in the city. They offer the option to go with a group or on your own. Both are great options and just depend on your preference. They provide the bike and all of the safety equipment you need for your trip. Guided Bike Tours The great thing about a guide is that you will learn a little more about the Golden Gate Bridge History during your stops. It also ensures that you find your way around and do not go too far off your path. If you like to plan ahead, then you can book your bike tour before you arrive. This cuts down on the amount of time you have to spend finding a rental shop when you arrive. The first three hours of the trip is with a guide. If you are there on the weekends, make sure you take the correct path. It is always very crowded and you will not even be able to ride your bike if you end up on the wrong side.

In October 19, , the Golden Gate Bridge became the first major bridge in the world to offer one-way toll collection. The system proved so successful it has since been instituted on many bridges throughout the world. In April , the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District initiated toll free passage on the Golden Gate Bridge for two-axle vehicles with three or more occupants, motorcycles, and buses during peak commute traffic hours. This free toll policy ended in July . For current carpool rates, hours, policies, and eligibility requirements, visit our Toll Rates page. The fog hugs the ground and then the warm, moist air condenses as it moves across the bay or land. This is common near any coastline. The Bridge has an influence in directing the fog as it pushes up and pours down around the Bridge. Sometimes, high pressure squashes it close to the ground. By the way, the color of the bridge is International Orange, and was chosen in part because of its visibility in the fog. The enabling legislation gave counties the right to organize as a bridge district and borrow money, issue bonds, construct a bridge and collect tolls. On November 10, , the California State Legislature passed Assembly Bill authorizing the District to develop a transportation facility plan for implementing a mass transportation program in the Golden Gate Corridor. This was to include any and all forms of transit, including ferry. At that time, the word "Transportation" was added to the District name. The longitude and latitude for the Bridge location is approximately: N 37 Degrees, 49 Minutes, 8. The dream of spanning the Golden Gate Strait had been around for well over a century before the Golden Gate Bridge opened to traffic on May 28, . With great fanfare, people from all over the world came to pay homage to the Bridge, become part of an historical celebration and create lifelong memories. The day began as "Bridgewalk 87", a reenactment of "Pedestrian Day 37". It is estimated that nearly , people surged onto the roadway. Chapter 9 : The Golden Gate Bridge: How to Cross to the Other Side - The Traveler's Way

The Golden Gate, as it is called in Christian literature, is the only eastern gate of the Temple Mount and one of only two that used to offer access into the city from that side. It has been walled up since medieval times.

This is the Golden Gate, which is the last of the eight gates leading into the Palestinian city of Jerusalem. Bricked in solid from top to bottom it is now contiguous with the wall itself, so that no one can enter or leave through its portals. The other seven gates were left open by the Moslems when they rebuilt the city and its walls many centuries ago, but this eighth gate they sealed in response to a Jewish tradition. Neither the Moslems nor the Jews believe that Jesus is the Messiah. Both look for someone else. So the expectation of his appearance remains. When the Moslems learned of this, they sealed the eastern gate to prevent anyone entering at this location. It has remained sealed to the present day. Christians understand that Jesus is the Messiah sent by God and that He made His entrance into Jerusalem almost years ago. The present wall of Jerusalem and its Golden Gate had not even been built at the time Jesus appeared. And it will occur at the end of time. The one who is coming is Michael the Archangel. When he appears on the Mount of Olives, the sealed golden gate will be opened by God, and it is through this opening that Michael will proceed on his journey into Jerusalem. As he enters, Michael will herald the second coming of Jesus Christ, whose brilliant re-appearance will follow right afterward, just as soon as Michael calls out the command. When the western wall comes down and the golden gate is made open to the east, it will be a sign to the whole world that the return of Jesus is imminent. It will be just the same then as it was in Jericho when the people of the Lord shouted the war cry: When they heard the sound of the trumpet, the people raised a mighty war cry and the wall collapsed then and there. The mighty war cry is the intonation that Jesus said the Jews must exclaim before they see Him again: How often have I longed to gather your children as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, and you refused! So be it, your house will be left to you desolate, for I promise, you shall not see me any more until you say: The sound of the trumpet is the musical blast Paul described in his letter to the Thessalonians: The Gates of Jerusalem Because they allow entrance through the walls that encompass the city of Jerusalem, each one of its eight gates have a symbolic meaning -- a meaning which points to Jesus -- the true master of Jerusalem. The seven open gates of this city stand for the seven churches of Christ. By preaching Jesus -- these churches are the seven gates to the Gospel which is Jesus -- the temple of the Lord. Seven is a symbolic number standing for the sum total of Christian worship on earth. The eighth gate -- the sealed gate -- stands for Judaism. Together they represent the two Houses of Israel. Spiritually, the eighth gate was sealed by God long before the Moslems came. This sealing took place in fact when the Jewish blindness was first decreed -- a decree announced by the Apostle Paul. For this reason, the opening of this gate points to the restoration of Jewish sight and to their reunion with the Lord at the end of time. This is why the golden gate will tumble open at the end -- as a signal to the Jews that the One they have been waiting for all these years is about to re-appear.
