December 14, By Donni 17 Comments As well as making handmade Christmas ornaments for the tree, the children and I have made a conscious choice to try to make all of our Christmas gifts this year. It takes time and effort, of course, but we have discovered that we have both of those gifts. So, for the girls in our family, who all happen to believe in fairies, we have made Flower Fairies. To make the Flower Fairies, we needed the following supplies: Cut off 1 third. Leave the other 2 thirds intact. Bend your larger section of pipe cleaner in half. Twist it until about half way down. This forms the body and legs of your fairy. Put the smaller section of pipe cleaner in place for the arms and twist them around the body to fasten them. Dismantle the silk flowers by pulling the petals apart. Thread the pipe cleaner legs through the hole in the middle of the flower petals. Thread two more petal skirts for a wonderful ruffled look. Choose a long length of embroidery floss in a color that compliments your fairies skirts and wind it around her upper body for a bodice. Wind it around her arms for a little sleeve too. Now she is really starting to look like a fairy! You can make different hair styles for your fairy. One of our fairies has a lovely long braid. We made this by looping yarn together 6 or 7 times and tying a knot at about the third-way mark. We then cut the ends off the loops on both sides. Teddy and Kitty chose little glass beads for our fairies hands and feet. Here they are, ready for the Flower Fairy Ball. Dressed in their pretty ballgowns. Teddy assures me that boys like these Flower Fairies too!

You can also use items from your local craft store as a substitute. You will need the Extra Fairies Pack. These are very small fairies. I find that using hot glue accelerates my work and allows me to skip drying time and secures the final product without worrying about things coming undone. Use what works best for you! Cut the special fairy wire into two pieces: This will make the body. Fold the 6 inch piece in half. Place the 2 inch piece at the top of the 6 inch piece and wrap top of 6 inch piece around 2 inch piece by looping. This will create the arms, legs, and base of head. Using your hands or needle-nose pliers, twist ends of arms to form hands. Wrap around until it is thick enough. Secure thread with glue or by tying a knot if possible. You can also use flower petals for a shirt instead, like the ones that come with the kit. Glue head bead onto post above embroidery thread. If you have the Klutz kit, your flowers will already be separated and loose. If you have bought silk flowers from the craft store, you will have to undo the stems in order to free the petals to use. Usually flowers is enough for this size fairy. I like to pick out flower petals to match the embroidery thread or create an interesting color combination. I also use different varieties and shapes of flower petals to create a unique layered look. Once you have all of your flowers on, you will use a bead to secure the flowers in place. Now, twist the bottoms of the feet the same way you did for the hands. The fairy can also have something to hold if you have small flowers on stems, small berry sprigs, tiny craft birds, etc. I also like to rub a little glitter glue on the flower petals to create a sparkle effect. A cute little flower fairy!
