He caught many thousands in his lifetime, sending some to London Zoo as food for their animals. All British snakes are now legally protected, and so the New Forest snakes are no longer caught. This strengthens our position. That is a long-term strategic vulnerability of which China is keenly aware, and which the United States appears not to have considered. That is war talk for public consumption, with a degree of vehemence that no Chinese government spokesman has employed in the past. But Beijing has concluded that Washington does not want specific trade concessions, the official continued, but rather wants China to abandon its economic policy of subsidizing nascent industries and acquiring advanced technology " in effect giving up its plans for economic development, in the Chinese perception. A prepared statement by the Defense Department warned: Continued globalization and our open society, both in academia and business, has offered China and others access to the same technology and information that is critical to the success of our future warfighting capabilities. China is making significant and targeted investments in the same technologies of interest to the Department. China has made it a national goal to acquire foreign technologies to not only advance its economy, but also to use these technologies to advance its military capabilities, and it is doing so through both licit and illicit means. Rosenstein, McCabe told the lawyer, wanted to furtively record the president to help explore whether Trump had obstructed justice. The lawyer, James Baker, dismissed the idea, according to people familiar with the episode who described it to The Washington Post on the condition of anonymity. Baker was not at the controversial meeting where Rosenstein broached the idea of a wiretap; his account to Congress, first reported by the Hill and Fox News, reflected what was relayed to him by other FBI officials with direct knowledge of the discussion. The former acting FBI director has told people that Rosenstein suggested using a wiretap on multiple occasions. Another person at the meeting, though, has said he did not take Rosenstein to be making a serious suggestion. At the time of the meeting, tensions were running high between Rosenstein and McCabe, and according to participants in the meeting, it was clear that both men were on edge. Justice Department officials at the meeting expressed concern that McCabe might have to recuse himself from the Russia probe, in part because of statements he had made at a congressional hearing after Trump fired FBI Director James B. Comey in May, according to people present. At the meeting, McCabe was resistant to any suggestion that he should recuse himself, according to people familiar with the matter. There was another reason Rosenstein and McCabe were in a standoff at the time: Advisers have also warned Trump "apparently successfully" that firing Rosenstein, who oversees Robert S. In the Trump administration, though, no one is ever truly ensconced in their job. So real was his belief that he would soon be fired that the Justice Department prepared a succession plan "only to scrap it just hours later so Rosenstein and the president could sit down face to face and discuss what had occurred.
