The skies were cloudless and blue, and the gray of the stone seemed a bit whiter and more pleasant in the sunlight. I only talked with a few people in Aberdeen. The city is busy. They are doing a two year mission throughout Ireland and Scotland. But, when you can see it impacting others, it means so much more. Chris is a native of Aberdeen. I asked him what the people of Aberdeen were like. I asked a similar question to a teenager who worked in Cafe Nero the night before. People are nice enoughâ€”with the exception of the younger guy who might be an â€”hole. And I hit gold. I watched the waitress walk over to the wall and open a small door to retrieve my food. They use a dumbwaiter to shuttle food from the kitchen to the cafe. That was a first for me. The brie and cranberry sandwich was a nice pairing with the carrot and coriander soup. The orange soup was speckled with spices and its heat matched the cold sandwich well. When I dipped the brie and cranberry, which had been quartered, into the soup, bits of the white cheese and purple fruit melted into the soup, adding a new touch of color as well as flavor. I was sated with good food, and I also knew that my money was going to a good cause. Aberdeen might be a city of wealth and sophistication. Those qualities are certainly here, and you could easily spend a fortune at its many high-end restaurants and shops. But the city of stone also has a lot of compassion etched within it. Department of Social Services A Code Blue Weather Emergency notice is issued when the temperature is forecast to drop to 32 degrees Fahrenheit or less between 4 p. Should you see an individual who appears to be homeless and in need out in the cold, please call and an outreach team will be dispatched to offer assistance. During Code Blue Weather emergencies, experienced outreach teams work to connect homeless New Yorkers with the following resources: During a Code Blue, shelter is available system-wide to accommodate anyone who is reasonably believed to be homeless and is brought to a shelter by outreach teams. Accommodations are also available for walk-ins. All drop-in centers are open hours per day, including when Code Blue procedures are in effect, and will assist as many people as possible for the duration of the emergency. Drop-in staff and the dedicated outreach teams they work closely with each and every day can also make arrangements for homeless individuals at other citywide facilities. Safe havens and stabilization beds: Chronically homeless individuals may be transported directly to these low-threshold housing programs. Teams will contact vulnerable individuals on their Code Blue Priority Lists a minimum of once every four 4 hours beginning at 8 p. If sites are not secured, the Department will take enforcement action - issuing violations and stop-work orders, where necessary. DOB is reminding all construction contractors and property owners to secure their work sites and buildings in advance of the inclement weather. To safeguard construction sites, builders, contractors, and developers should take all precautionary measures including but not limited to the following: Tie down and secure material and loose debris at construction sites. Cover electrical equipment from exposure to the weather. Secure netting, scaffolding, and sidewalk sheds. Clear icicles and vulnerable snow masses from sidewalk sheds, and supported and suspended scaffolds. Clear roofs, overhangs and gutters of melting snow and ice. Brace and secure construction fences. Call if there is an emergency on a construction site. To secure a building, property owners should take all precautionary measures including but not limited to the following: Bring inside loose, lightweight objects such as lawn furniture, potted plants, garbage cans, garden tools, and toys. Anchor objects that would be unsafe outside, such as gas grills or propane tanks. Secure and clear roofs, awnings, umbrellas and overhangs of melting snow and ice. Ensure gutters are clear of debris to allow drainage. Department of Housing Preservation and Development Residential building owners are legally required to maintain indoor temperatures at 68 degrees when it falls below 55 degrees outside during the day, and a minimum of 62 degrees indoors overnight, regardless of outdoor temperatures. If an apartment lacks appropriate heat, a tenant should first attempt to notify the building owner, managing agent or superintendent. If heat is not restored, the tenant should register an official complaint via Tenants can call , visit online at www. If you have to drive, drive slowly. Vehicles take longer to stop on snow and ice than on dry pavement. Four-wheel drive vehicles may make it easier to drive on snow-covered roads, but they do not stop quicker than other vehicles. Use major streets or highways for travel whenever possible. Vehicles with anti-lock brakes require a different braking technique than vehicles without anti-lock brakes in snowy conditions. If you

are driving and begin to skid, ease your foot off the gas and steer in the direction you want the front of the car to go. Straighten the wheel when the car moves in the desired direction. If you have an anti-lock braking system ABS , apply steady pressure to the brake pedal. Never pump the brakes on an ABS equipped vehicle. Keep the name and phone number of at least one local towing service in your car in case you break down or become stuck. For Pedestrians Exercise caution and avoid slippery surfaces; some ice may not be visible. Wear sturdy boots that provide traction to reduce slipping. Use handrails when using stairs. Seniors should take extra care outdoors to avoid slips and falls. Have heightened awareness of cars, particularly when approaching or crossing intersections. If you have to go outdoors, wear dry, warm clothing and cover exposed skin. Keep fingertips, earlobes, and noses covered. Wear a hat, hood, scarf, and gloves. Shivering is an important first sign that the body is losing heat. Shivering is a signal to return indoors. Be careful when shoveling snow. Cold weather puts an extra strain on the heart. Be safe at work. Workers who spend a lot of time outdoors are at risk for cold-related health impacts. If you are an employer, implement safe work practices, provide appropriate protective equipment, and train workers on how to stay safe during cold and winter weather. Drinking alcohol may make you feel warmer but it causes your body to lose heat faster. Alcohol also impairs your judgment which limits your ability to take appropriate precautions or remove yourself from a dangerously cold environment in time.
